BLUE MOON OVER WET MONSOON

The exhibit "blue moon over wet monsoon" at the Römerthermen Zülpich – Museum der Badekultur showcases key-works by Rolf A. Kluenter, which had their specific beginning during his 18 years long stay in Kathmandu, Nepal from 1980 until 1998. For the first time, three different work cycles are being exhibited together that are taking into account different ideas related to the element of water.

Kluenter's paintings on blackened handmade Nepalese paper, four art films and the central paper-installation are inviting the visitor to contemplate his abstract and spiritual works related to the element of water.
